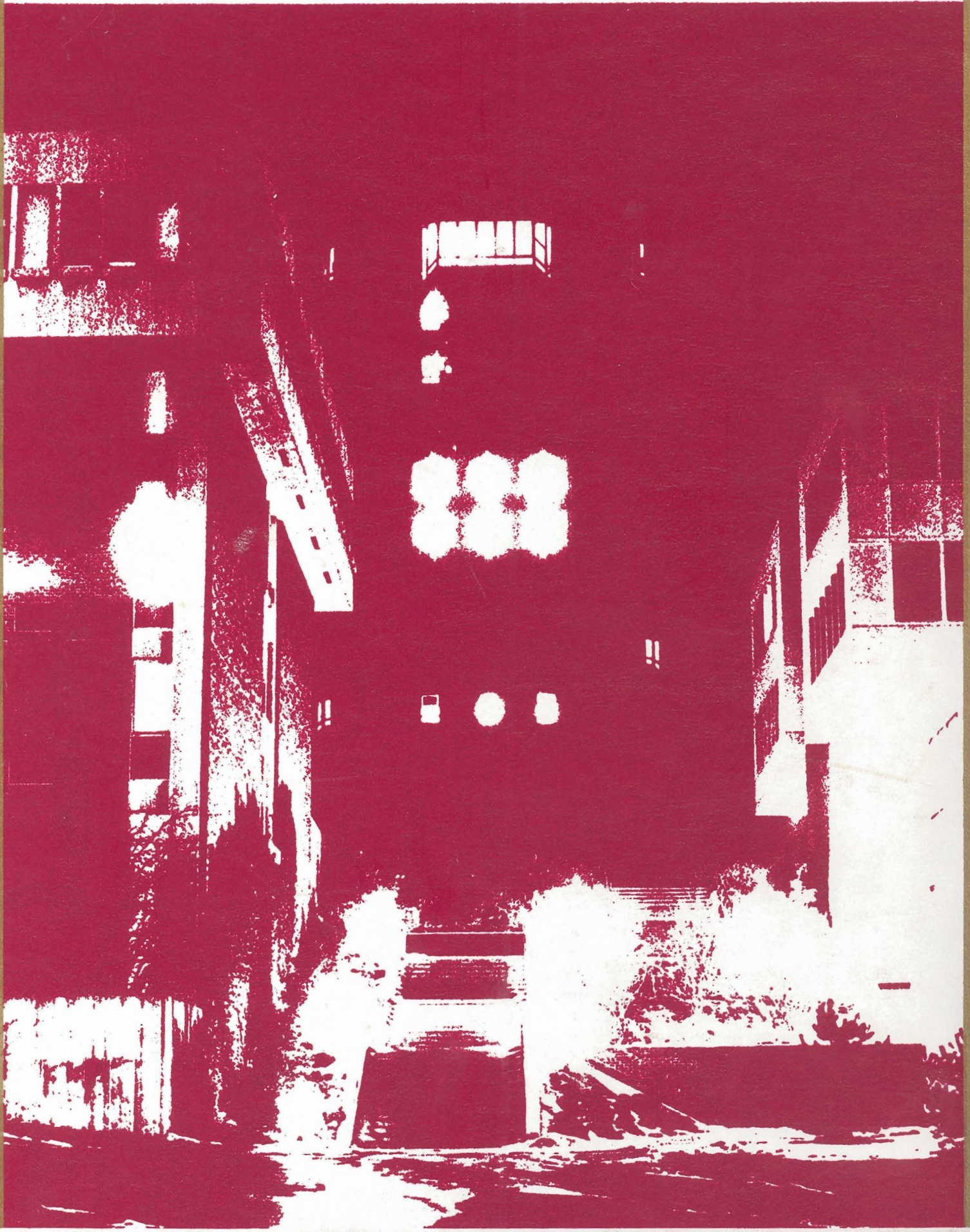



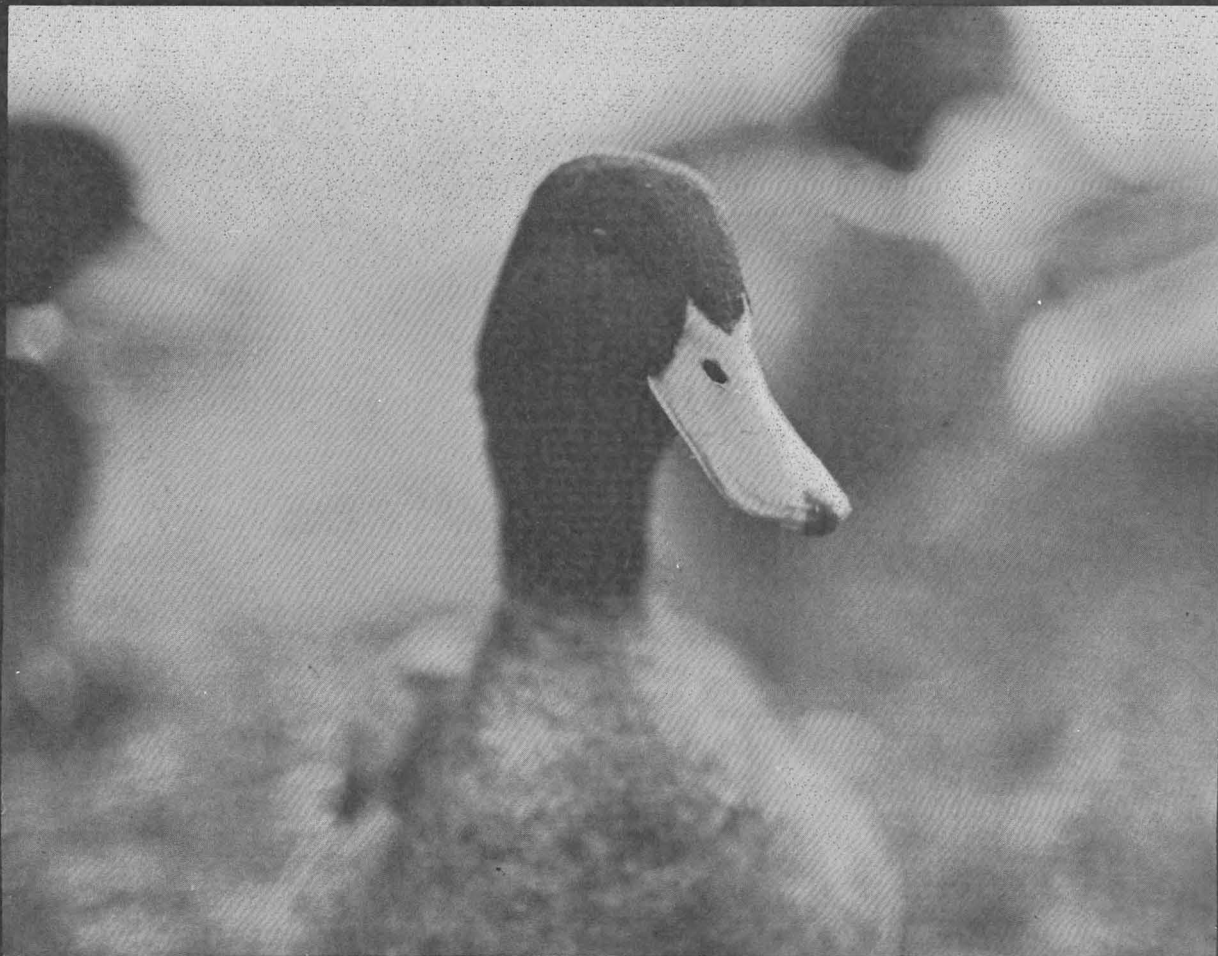

UMSL'S PATH—PAST AND PRESENT

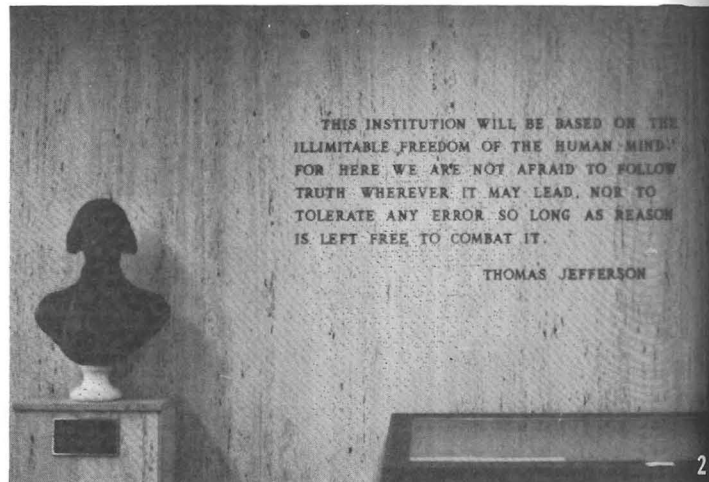
The University of Missouri-St. Louis was founded in 1963 to meet the higher educational needs of the metropolitan area and thus, enhance the quality of life of St. Louis citizens. Built on the old Bellerive Country Club, UMSL has gone from one building (old Administration Building) to nine buildings plus Merillac. Merillac was obtained by UMSL in 1976, and was originally a college of the Daughters of Charity.

With the new decade of the 80's comes hopes of expanding UMSL's student population of 11,000, introducing new programs and improving the old. As a public university UMSL's aim is low-cost, high quality education. The university has established three major schools of learning (Arts and Sciences, Business, and Education) and plans on adding many new schools, such as a School of Optometry and a School of Law.

Many improvements are planned on campus including an increase in the number of parking spaces and building a stronger athletic program.

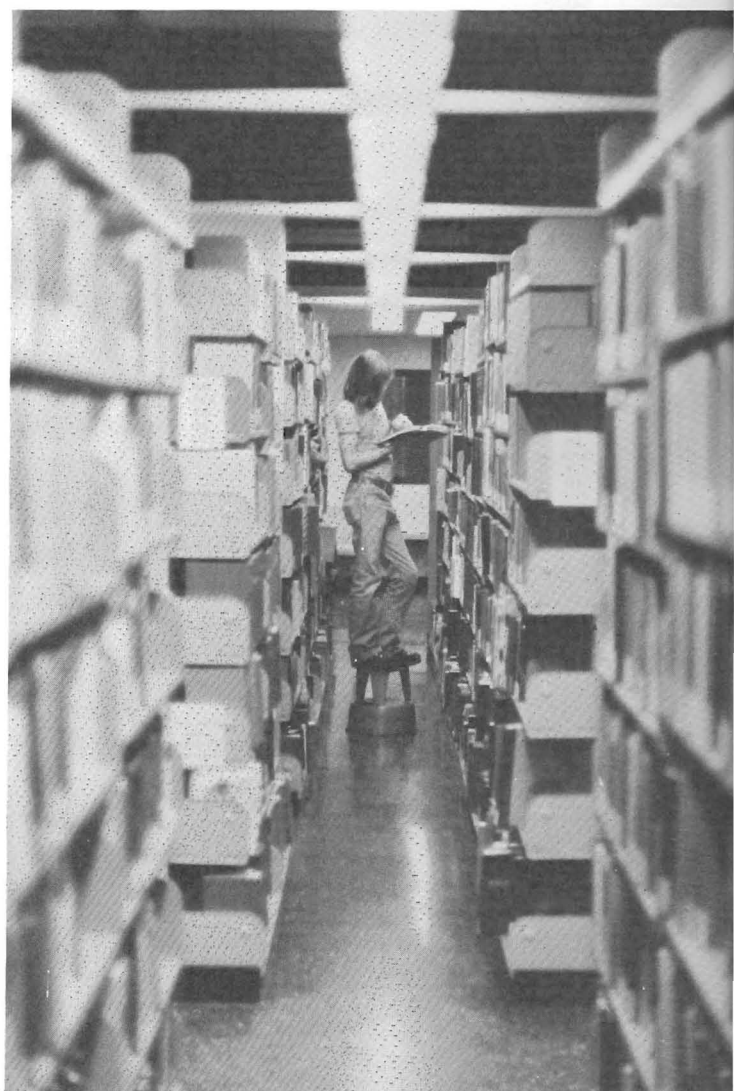
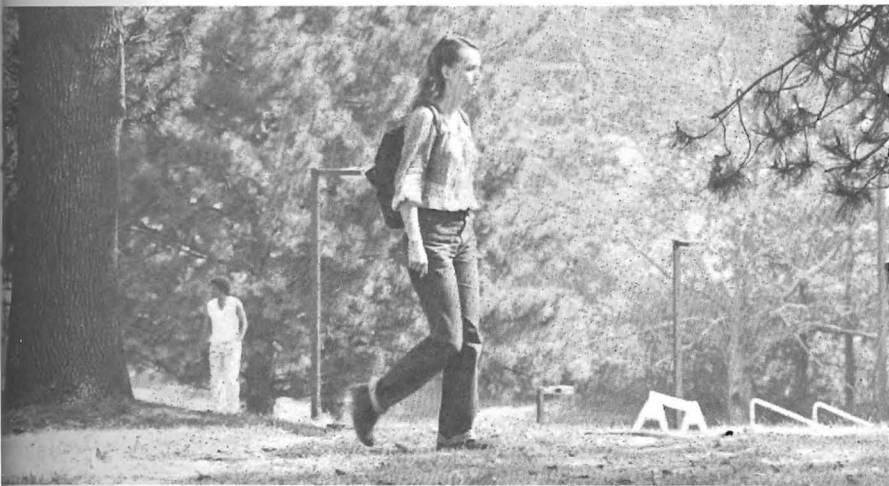
UMSL seeks to reach out to St. Louis with its satellite program. In this program educational centers will be established throughout the area.

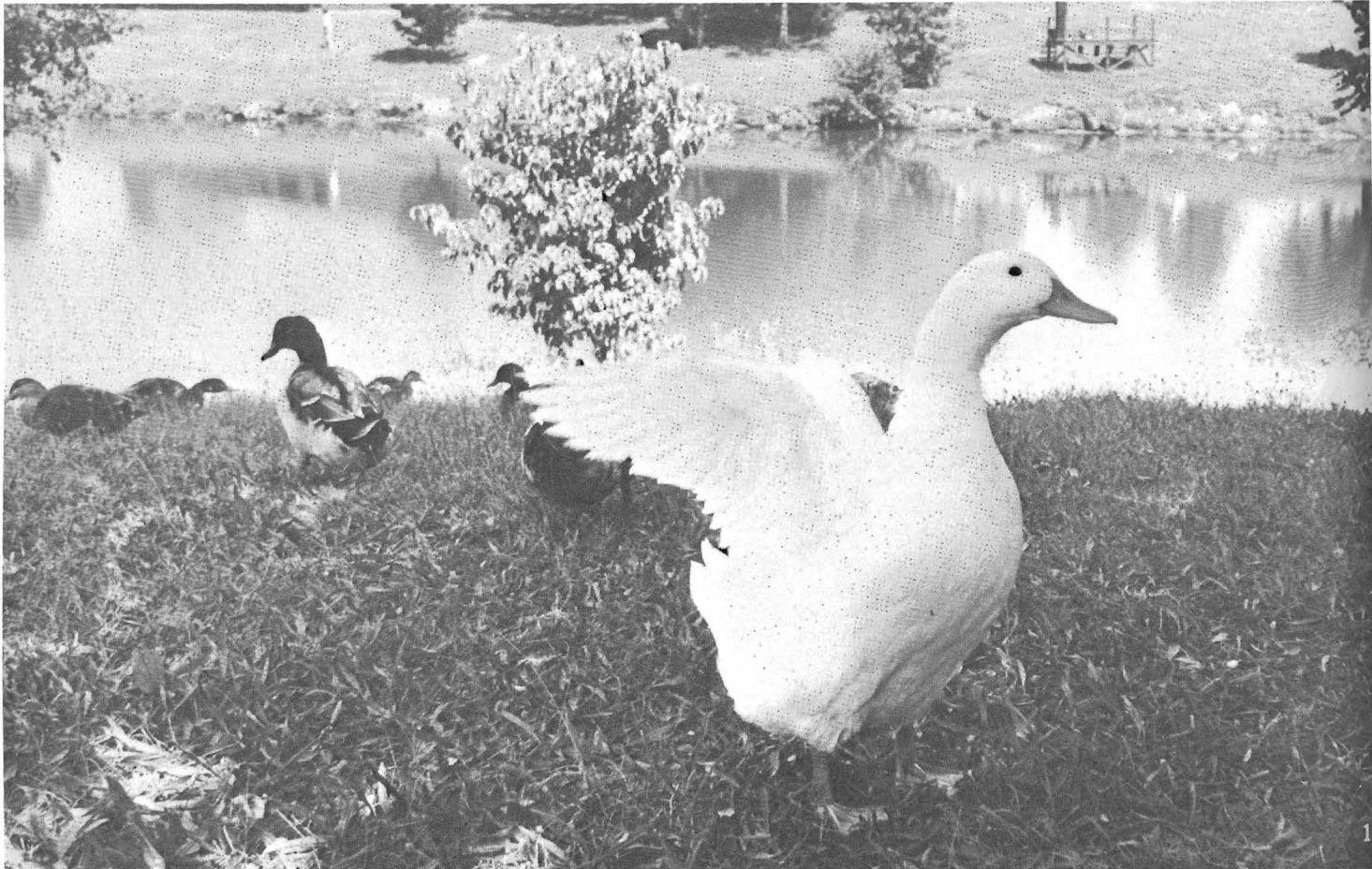

A view of the west side of the Thomas Jefferson Library.



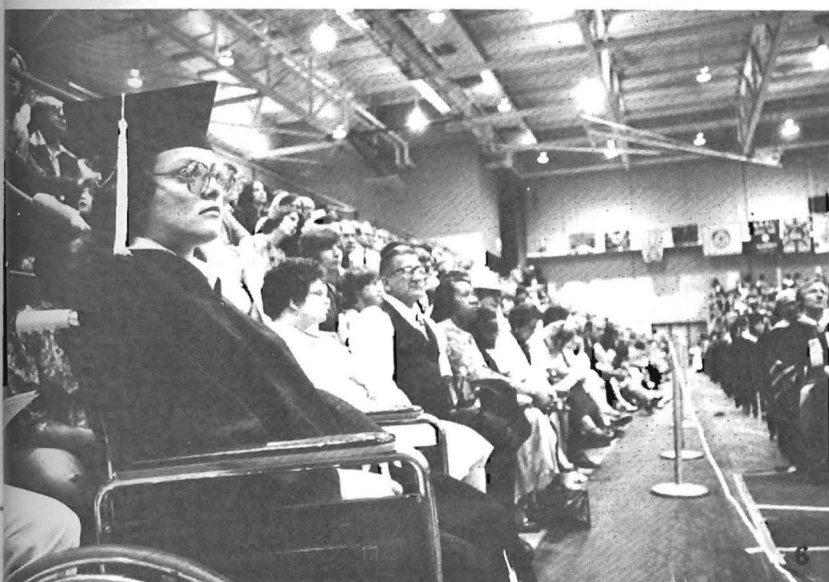
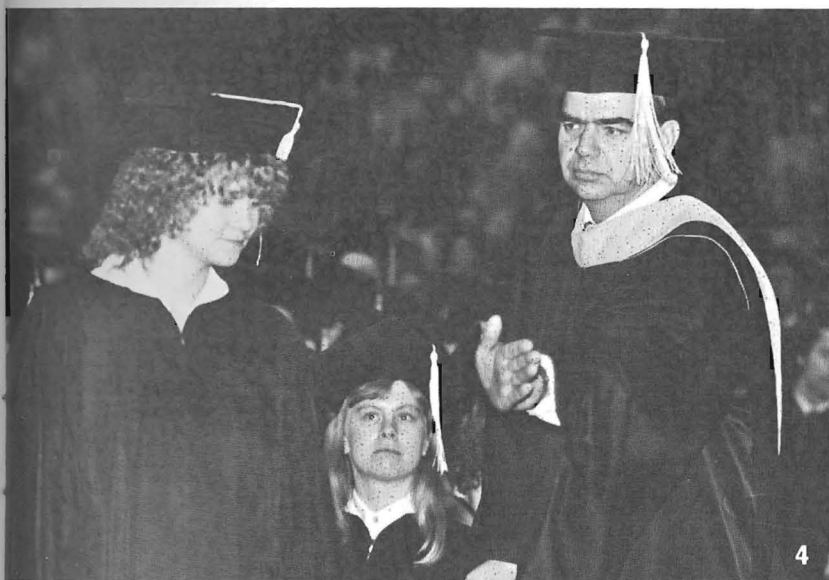
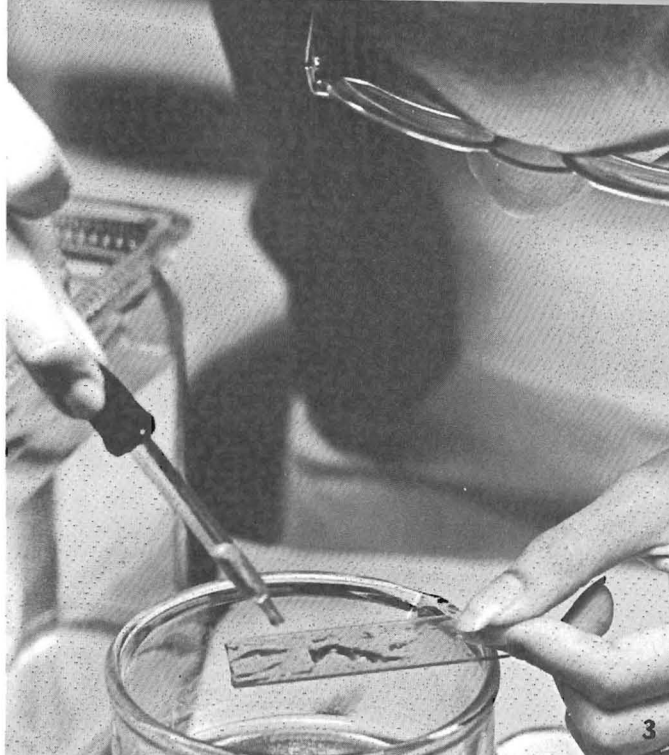


UMSL SIDESTEPPING: A CANDID LOOK

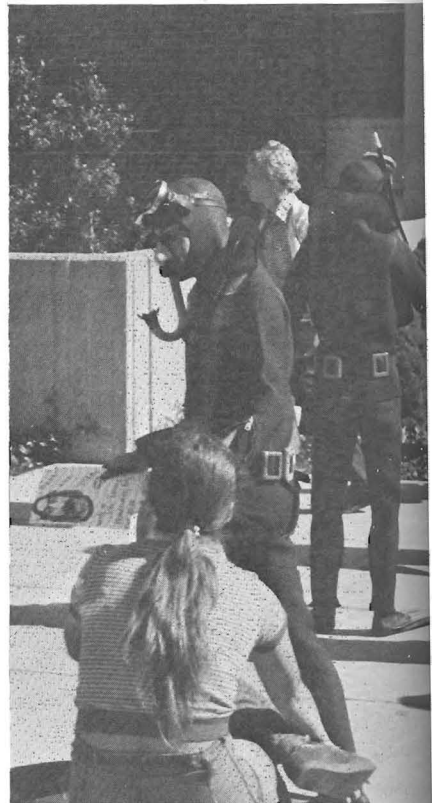
SPIRIT OF HOMECOMING

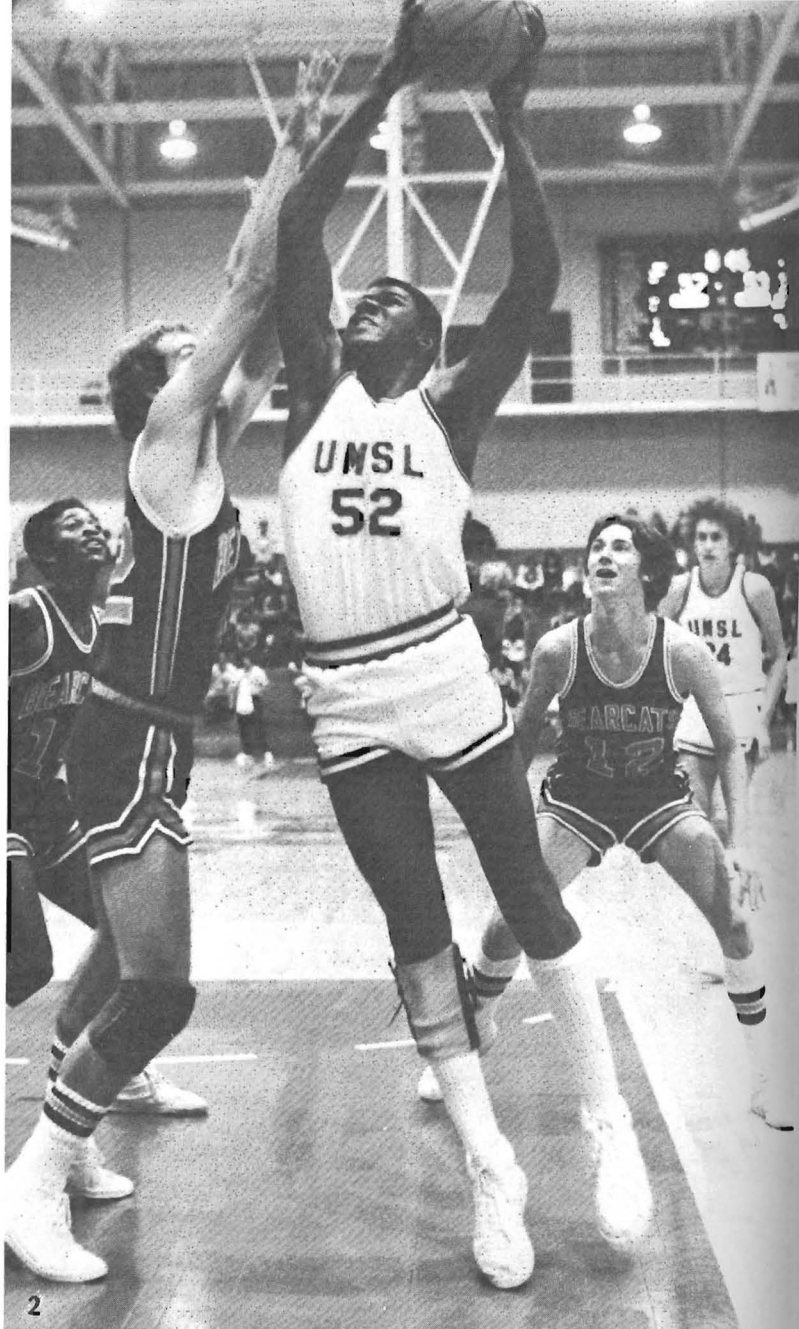
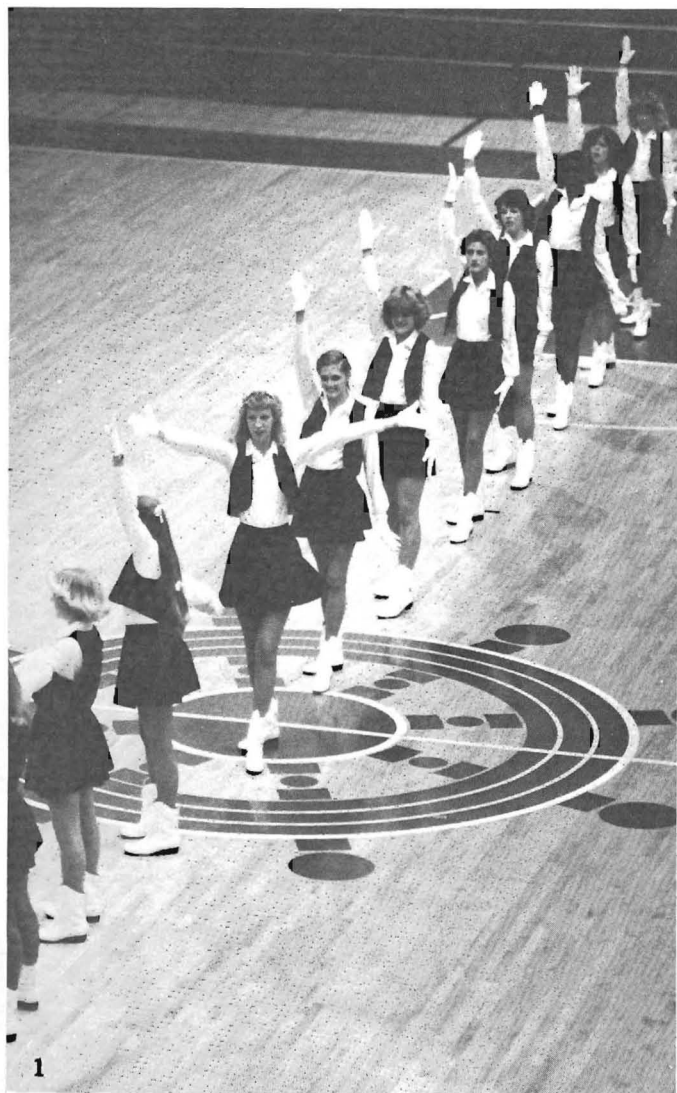
LEAPS AND BOUNDS, ETC.

Whether one is a participant or spectator, the athletic program at UMSL has something for everyone. Intercollegiate teams, known as the Rivermen and the Riverwomen, have established UMSL as a legitimate NCAA Division Power. Four teams (basketball, soccer, baseball, and golf) have participated in post season NCAA tournaments, while individual Rivermen have gained district, regional, and all-American honors. Competition at the intercollegiate level is in eight varsity sports: baseball, basketball, cross-country, golf, soccer, swimming, tennis, and wrestling. Intercollegiate sports in the women's program include field hockey, volleyball, basketball, softball, tennis, and swimming. In addition to intercollegiate sports, UMSL also has a well developed intramural program with men's, women's and co-ed's sections in such areas as basketball, racquetball, tennis, etc.

To meet these needs and those with individual athletic interests there is the Mark Twain Building, where all indoor intercollegiate and intramural-recreational activities are conducted. The Mark Twain Building has an indoor swimming pool, two courts available for handball and racquetball, a fully equipped weight room and conditioning room, and a training room and locker rooms for both men and women. The building's gymnasium has a seating capacity of 6500 when all benches are utilized. With all benches retracted, the gym houses three basketball courts on the main floor as well as one court on each of the deck areas which are one floor above the main basketball court. In addition to the indoor facilities housed in the Mark Twain Building, the UMSL athletic complex contains approximately six acres of outdoor space including a soccer field, baseball diamond, and tennis courts.

STUDENT GOV'T A CLOSER LOOK

The Central Council is the student government at UMSL. The council's purpose, as defined by its constitution, is to provide greater student participation in the general administration and government of UMSL and to promote the general welfare of the academic community. This is accomplished by working with faculty and administrators to maintain an institution of increasing service to students, alumni, the metropolitan community, and the state.

The student government has a dual role. First, it represents the student body in all facets of university governance. Secondly, the student government provides services to the UMSL student by developing new programs, and sponsoring activities as well as helping other organizations provide services to the UMSL community.
